

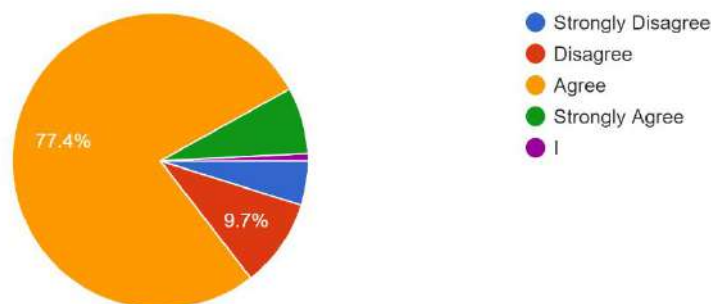
Analysis Report on Feedback Collected from Different Stakeholders for Academic Year: 2023-24

INTRODUCTION

The IQAC Committee of the institution designs and collects feedback from the stakeholders such as students, teachers, alumni and employers to monitor and evaluate its performance quality on curriculum related issues. Once the feedback is analysed and valuable suggestions are considered then necessary action is taken. Multiple questionnaires consisting of various questions were framed for different stakeholders by the IQAC Committee. We have collected online feedback from students, teachers, alumni through google forms and received a good amount of feedback. IQAC cell collects feedback from employers in physical mode through a questionnaire filled by them during placement drives in college. Placement cell organises placement drives for final year students on regular basis every year. Infosys, tech Mahindra, Wipro, Varinda global and ICICI bank are our regular employers.

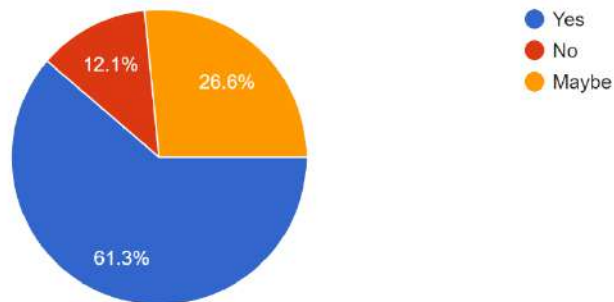
Students Feedback (Academic Year 2023-24)

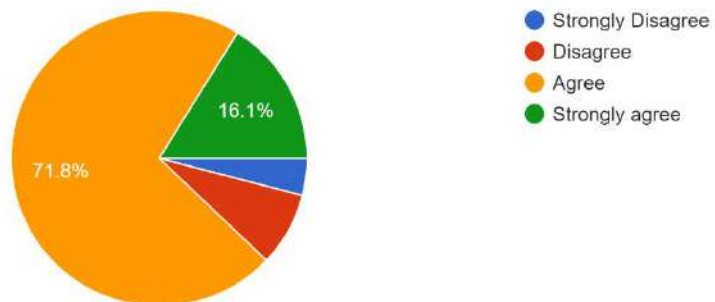
Syllabus is completed in time

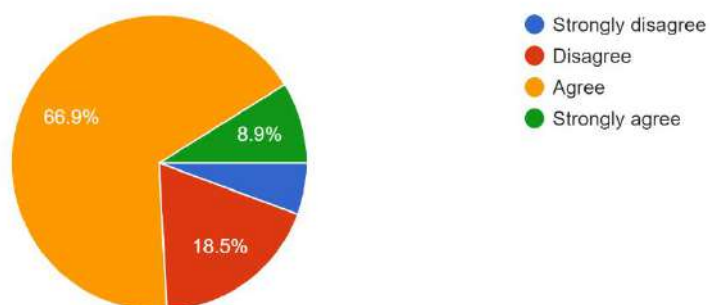
Teachers' behavior towards students is supportive

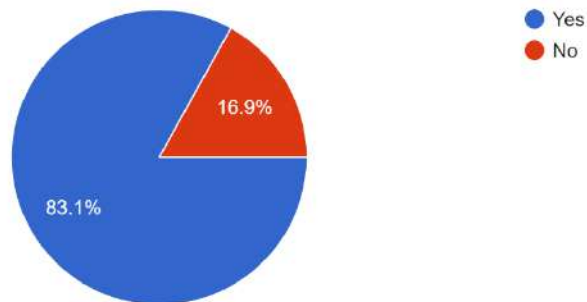
Institute provides multiple opportunities to grow and learn

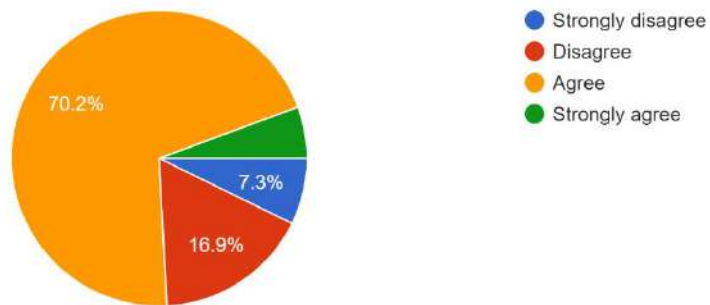
Sufficient availability of library resources

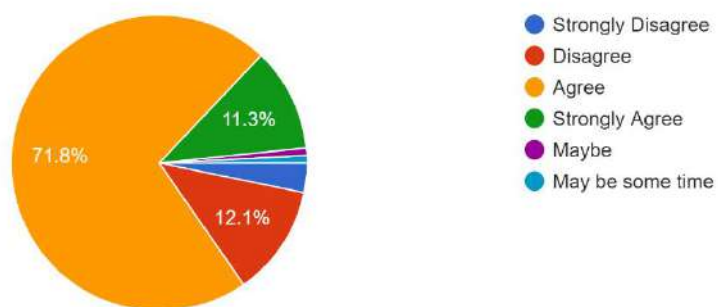
Institute responds timely to your grievances to your satisfaction

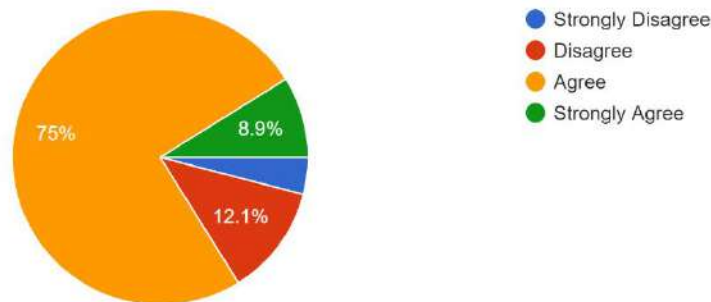
Elective papers are supportive to main papers

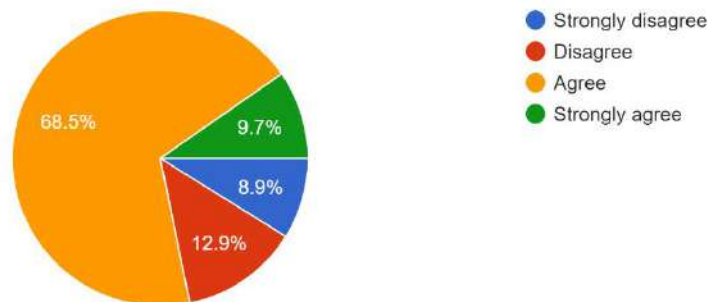
Institute is able to promote fair competitive learning environment

Of the responses, 85% of the students agree that the curriculum is up-to-date, need-based and application oriented. 83% of student respondents agree that the reference books and other study material are sufficiently available in the library. On the rating of the different areas of the college such as teaching and learning, student-teacher interaction, coverage of syllabus, fairness of internal evaluation process, teachers' approach to teaching, feedback mechanism etc, the majority of the feedback was positive but some students strongly feel that the curriculum should be updated periodically so that it can be more relevant towards current industry trends. Around 80% students rated the college as a good institute in the sense of academic performance and ambience. Some students mentioned some suggestions as:

All over teachers are supportive but there can be some improvement in infrastructure

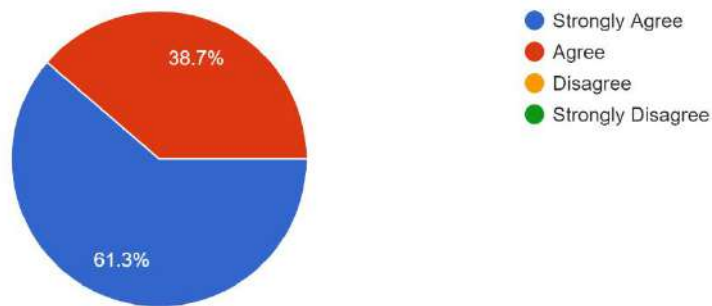
More varieties in newspapers and magazines in the library for example the tribune magazine

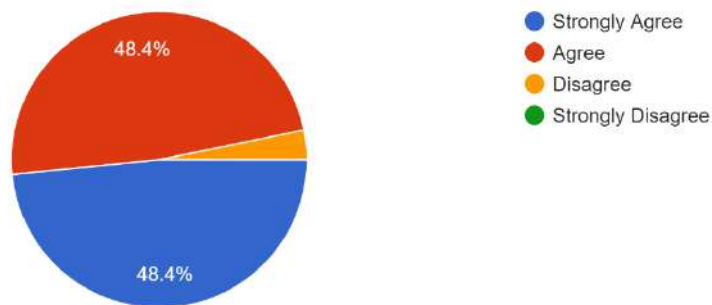
The institution has conducive environment for teaching and learning

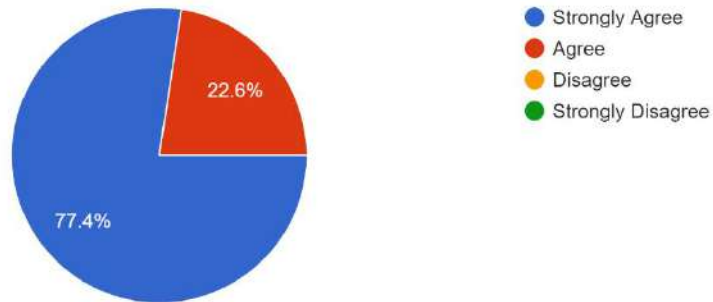


I am quite satisfied that my institution provides me adequate facilities to carry out my work effectively

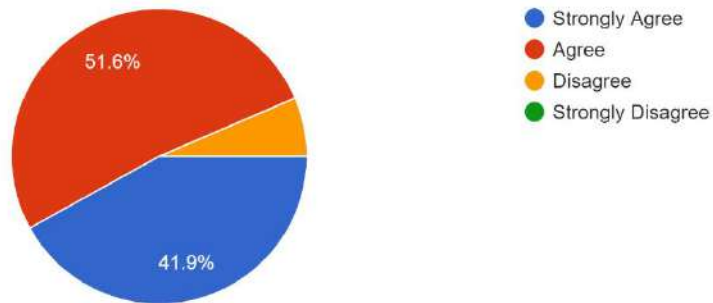

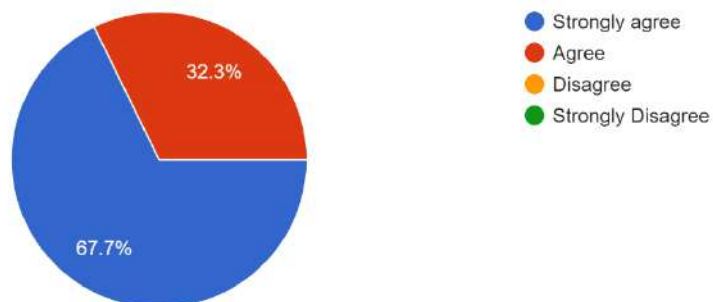
The discipline in the college is monitored effectively

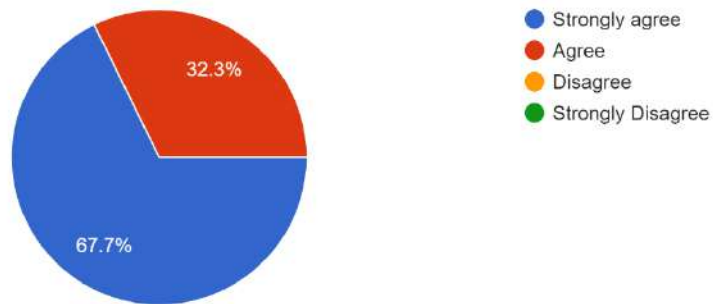
Curriculum is effective to face the competitions

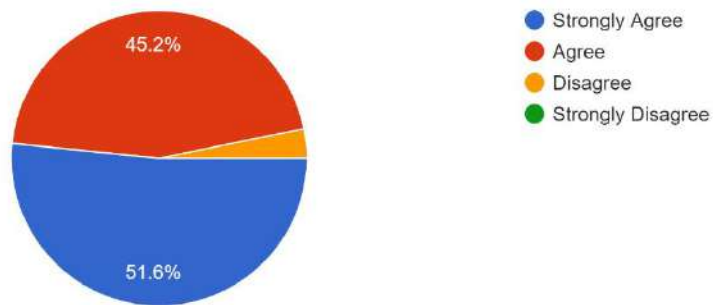
The teachers are encouraged to participate in seminars, workshops and conferences etc.

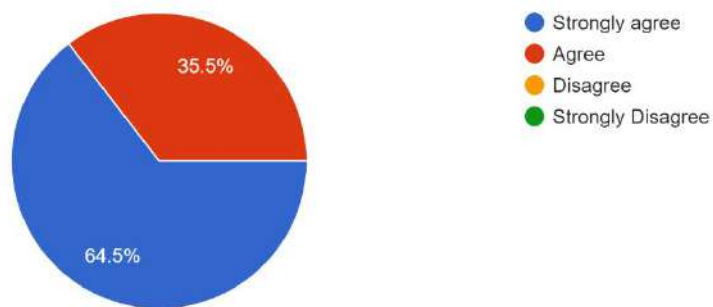
The teachers are encouraged to organize seminars workshops and conferences etc.

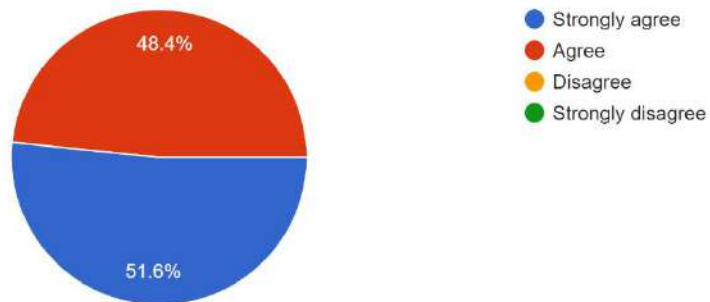


The examination system followed by the college is effective

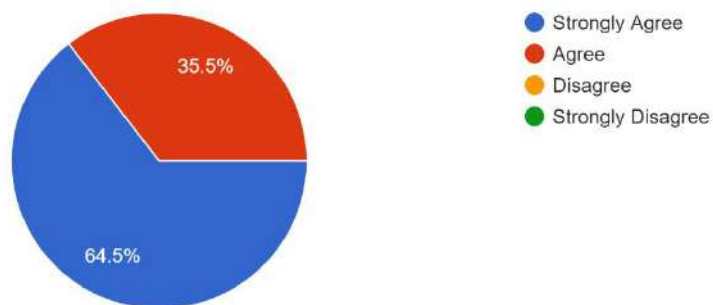
The infrastructure available in the college is properly utilized

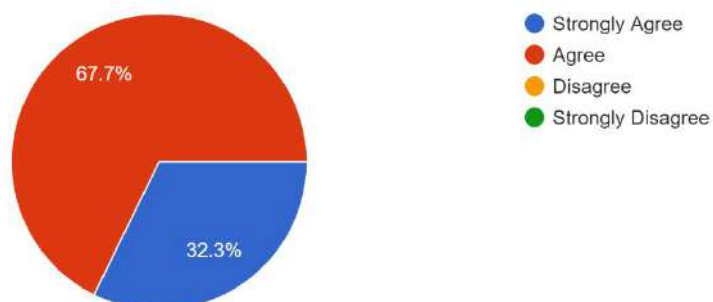

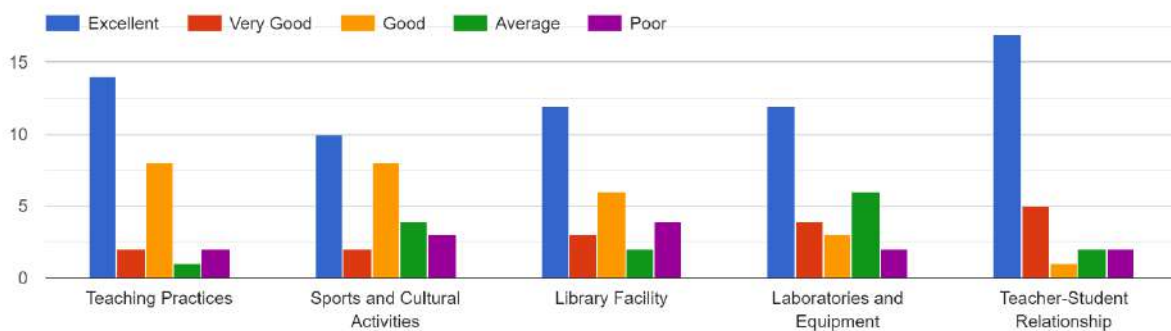

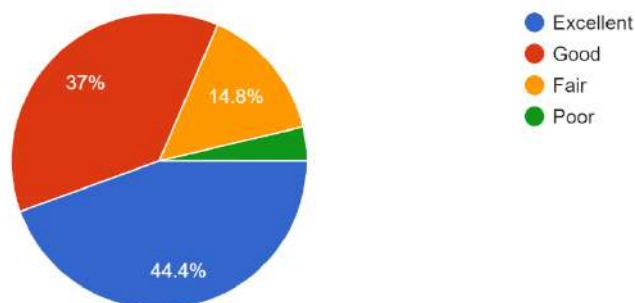

Please rate the college on the following parameters;



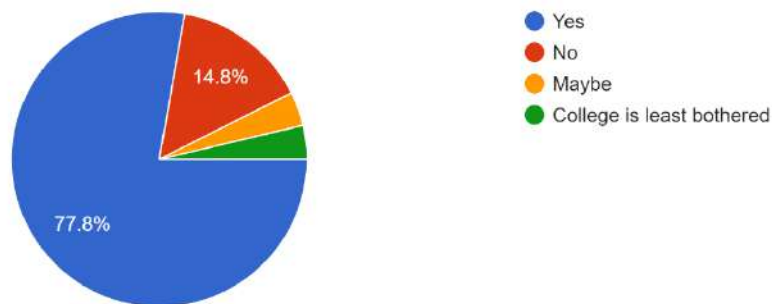
Environment of the college for studies

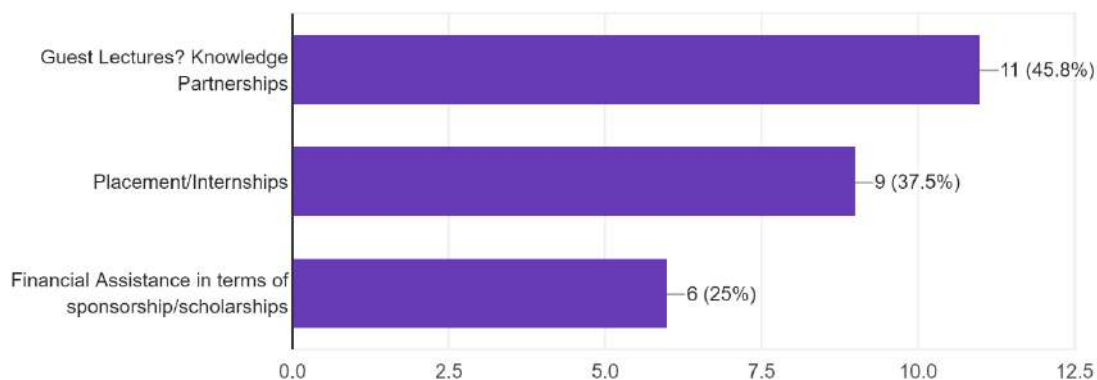
Are you satisfied with the efforts taken by the College to connect with its Alumni?

By analysing the feedback, the majority of the alumni are satisfied with the different aspects of the college as teaching- learning process, environment of the college, teacher-student relation. They feel teachers are very helpful and caring towards their students. The college is very good in terms of sports, cultural activities. College has a very rich library and very good and well-equipped laboratories. Overall feedback received from our alumni is very positive and satisfactory. Some alumni gave very good suggestions as college should organise alumni meet more frequently, do more efforts to connect more alumni, there should be more focus on placement and internship.

Employer Feedback (2023-24)

We receive feedback from our valued employers during the placement drives and frequent recruiting partners through well designed feedback forms. This feedback provides valuable insights into our students' strengths and areas for improvement, guiding us towards enhancing our placement readiness and overall employability.

The questionnaire contains different questions regarding different parameters of student behaviour and their work attitude like Communication, Skills Ability to learn new things, Proactiveness, Team Work, Leadership Skills, Managerial Skills, Technical knowledge and skills, analytical and problem-solving skills, analytical and problem-solving skills and Ability to take up extra responsibility.

Very positive feedback on the curriculum was received from the employer. They agree that the curriculum is helpful in enhancing team-work, developing analytical and problem-solving skills, enhancing constructive learning ability, developing communication skills and it has relevance to real-life situations, reflects current trends and practices in the respective disciplines. They also suggested that the college should focus more on strengthening vocational courses to enhance self-employability of its students, improving communication skills. Personality development must be an integral part of the curriculum and short-term skill-based courses can be introduced.

College Library is very rich and per year new books are added to enrich it more. A number of books for competitive exams are available in the library. Due to the change in the syllabus and introduction of NEP, the books, journals and e-journals worth Rs 1.3758 lacs were purchased in this session.

Internship is an important feature of NEP 2020. Internship committee has been constituted so as to reach out to every student. To facilitate the process, number of companies and organisation are being contacted and MOUs are being signed.
